 Minnesota Land Cover Classification System or other methodologies subject to approval of Hennepin County
- Floristic quality assessments
- ArcGIS Project creation including digitization and geodatabase creation
- Natural resources protection, restoration and/or enhancement projects and installation

Typical services

Project deliverables may include the following:

- Design specifications, data, reports, maps, and other documentation of the results of the services listed in Section I
- Supporting documents used to conduct the services and complete the reports including, but not limited to ArcGIS projects and associated databases
- Documentation of required certifications, where applicable
- Completion of regulatory reporting requirements, if required
- Meeting attendance, as required



- Properly trained and certified staff as required by federal and state statutes and regulations and/or Hennepin County policy
- Proper equipment necessary for the completion of the assigned task(s)
