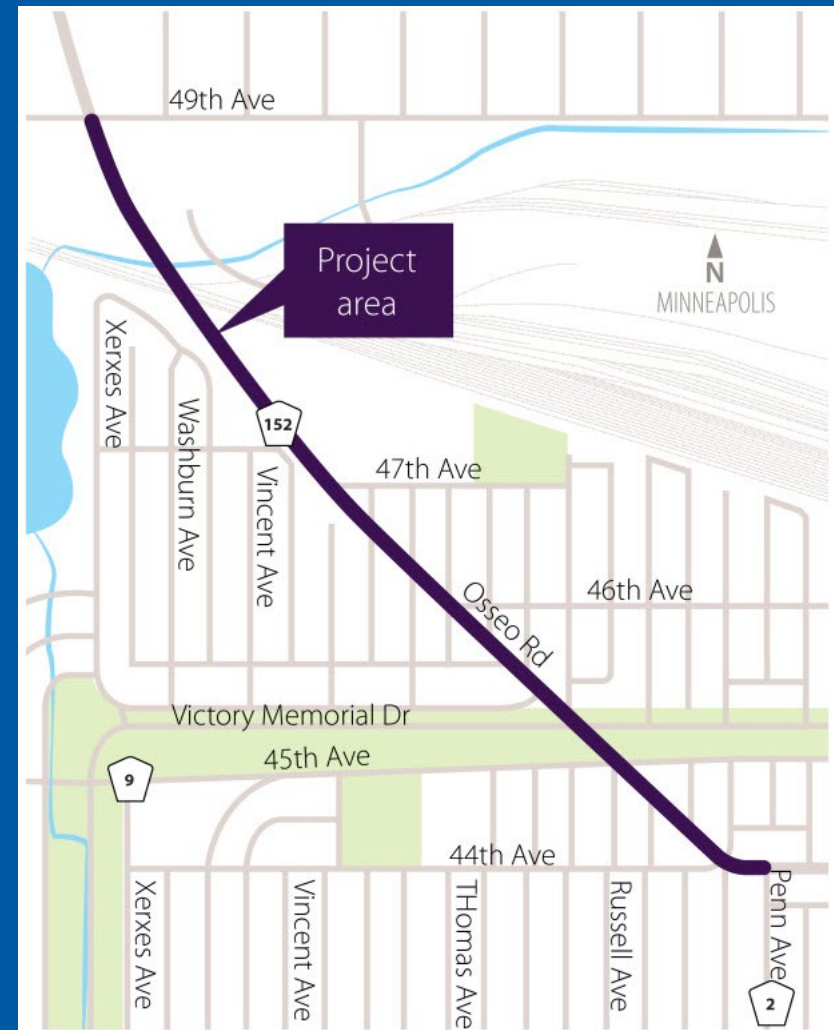


Osseo Road (County Road 152) between Penn Avenue (County Road 2) and 49th Avenue in North Minneapolis

Project upgrades

- New roadway pavement
- Bridge deck replacement
- Storm sewer upgrades
- New infiltration basins
- New sidewalks and curb & gutter

Project upgrades

- Signalization upgrades at 49th Ave, Victory Memorial Parkway and Penn Avenue
- New rapid flashing beacons for pedestrian crossing at 47th Avenue and Queen Avenue
- New Bicycle Trail on south side of Osseo Rd from 49th Avenue to Queen Avenue
- New lighting

What to expect during construction

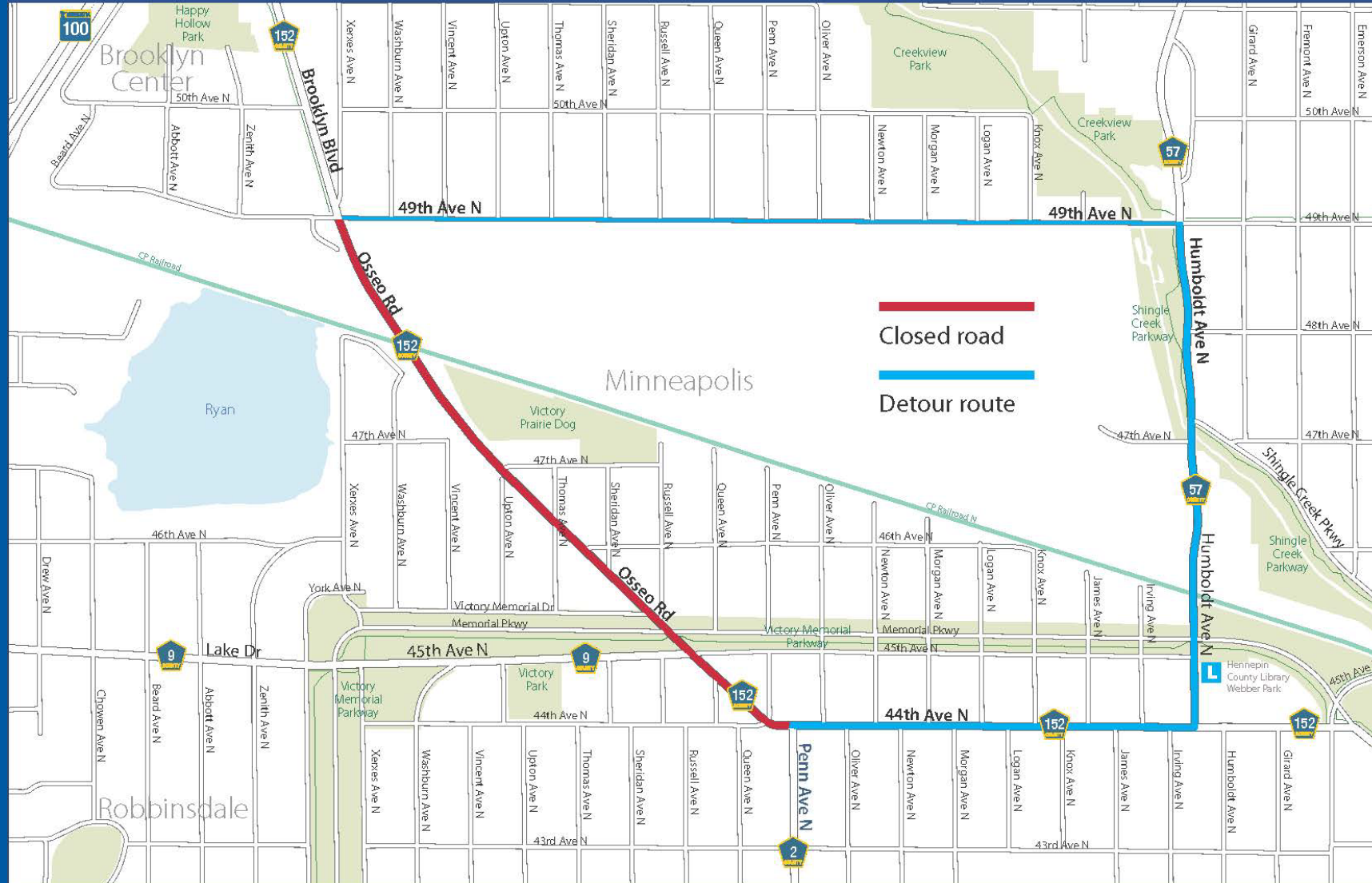
Construction details – Traffic control

- Spring – Fall 2023: Contractor will have CSAH 152 (Osseo Rd) closed from 49th Avenue to just south of Victory Memorial Pkwy. 45th Avenue will remain open to traffic.
- Spring – Summer 2024: Contractor will have Osseo Road closed from just north of 45th Avenue to Penn Avenue.
- Victory Memorial Pkwy will be open to traffic.

Construction details – Official detour

- Official Detour will be East-West on 44th Avenue to North-South on Humboldt Avenue to East-West on 49th Avenue.
- Either 45th Avenue or Victory Memorial Pkwy will remain open to traffic at all times.
- Using the signed detour and access routes will keep you from experiencing additional delays and getting frustrated. It will also help local streets stay safe for the individuals and families who live and play in the area.

Osseo Road (County Road 152) Closure and detour



Construction details – Pedestrian access

- Pedestrian access will be maintained on one side of Osseo Rd.
- At each intersection one route will be provided for pedestrians to cross Osseo Rd.
- Expect roadway surfaces to be gravel as crews remove the existing pavement.
- Expect temporary paths for people walking, biking and rolling to access these destinations.
- Expect that temporary paths to be gravel with rubber mats, and there may be other challenges when crossing at intersections.

Construction details – Adjacent property coordination

- Temporary easement has been staked at all properties
- Water services and sanitary services may need replacement or relocation – this work will be coordinated with property owners
- Disturbed lawn will be restored
- Driveway and sidewalk entry construction will be coordinated with property owners

Construction details – Adjacent property coordination

- Contractor will be required to maintain the grass after seeding for a period of 60 days. If the grass is in acceptable condition, notice will be provided to property owners with information on best practices for maintaining boulevard grass.
