Project background



Osseo Road is part of County Road 152 and is a connector between the soon-to-be-finished Brooklyn Boulevard reconstruction project in Brooklyn Center and next year's Webber 44 reconstruction project in Minneapolis



Hennepin County will be reconstructing Osseo Road between Penn and 49th Avenues



The existing roadway has reached the end of its service life and is due for replacement

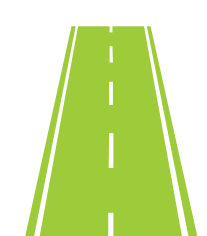


Initial design is underway and construction is anticipated to begin in 2022

Improve roadway and intersection safety

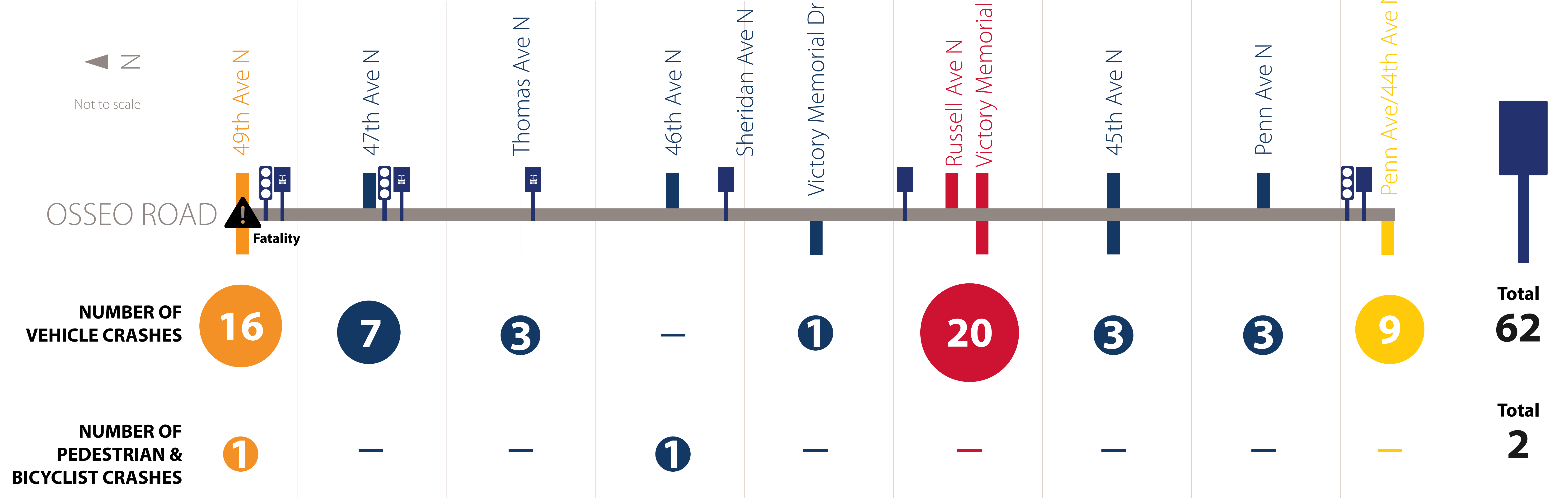


Review traffic signal opportunities to enhance traffic operations

AVERAGE DAILY BUS RIDERSHIP (2018)



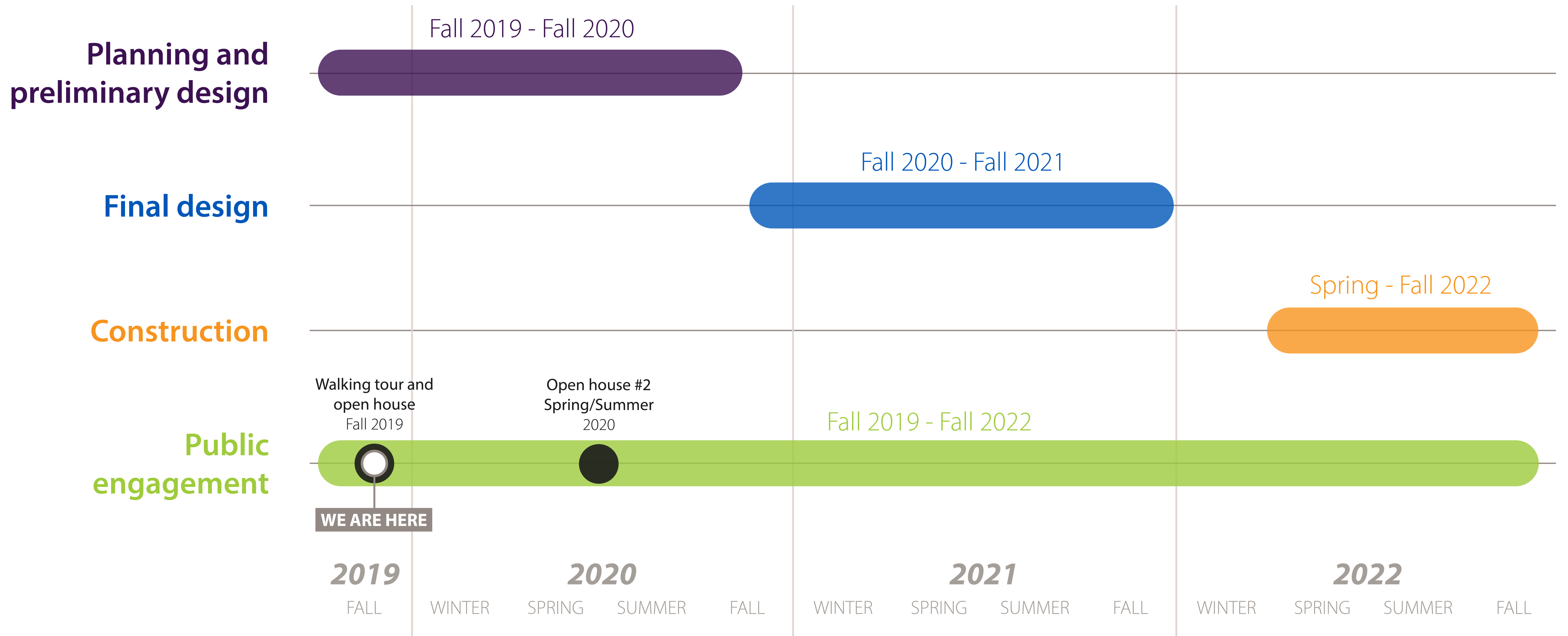

Walking

- People don't feel safe walking along Osseo Road
- Sidewalk improvements are needed



Biking

- Osseo Road is not good for people biking



Driving

- Traffic calming is needed:
 - › Improve driver awareness of speeds
 - › Encourage additional speed enforcement
- Consider left turn arrow at Victory Memorial Parkway
- Consider a roundabout at the intersection of Victory Memorial Parkway and Osseo Road



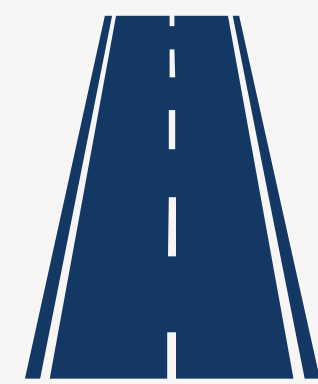

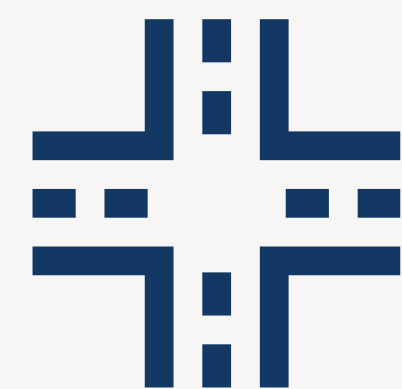

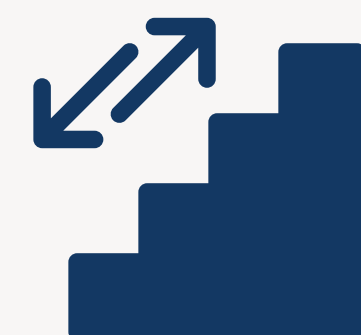
