Capital Budgeting Task Force

Committee Summary

Origin

As allowed by State Statute 383B.113, the task force was established in May 1973 to review county departments' requested capital budget and program.

Composition

11 members:

- Each commissioner appoints one member.
- The County Board appoints four members at large.
- The County Board appoints the chair by separate resolution.

Duties/Responsibilities

The task force submits to the Hennepin County Board a recommended annual capital budget and five-year capital improvement program. The administrative staff assigned to work with the task force prepare the detail data for the task force to analyze, and the staff coordinate task force reports and subject matter. The task force is required to read, study, discuss, and make recommendations concerning capital projects. They are expected to attend most scheduled meetings to keep current, hear briefings from various departments, and participate in group discussions of topics under review, and express viewpoints candidly on subject topics.

Term

- Commissioner-appointed members: at pleasure of the appointing commissioner, automatic expiration when such commissioner leaves office.
- At-large members: 4 years. No limit to number of terms. Reapplication required.



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Meetings

The task force meets an average of 10 times a year, generally June through August. The task force tours county facilities, as needed.
